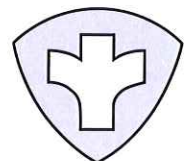

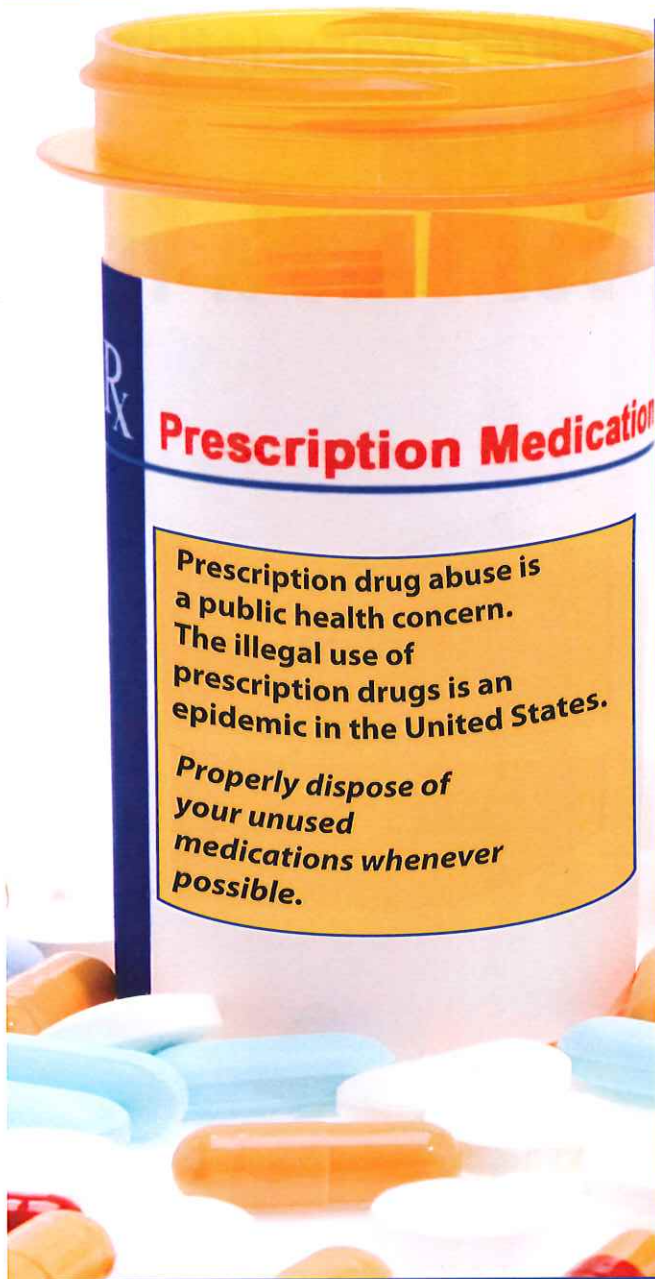

Proper Medicine Disposal at Home



When designated prescription drop-off locations are not available, please see below for proper method for disposal:

- Do **NOT** flush unused medications down the toilet.
- Take them out of their original container.
- Mix them with an undesirable substance, such as coffee grounds and kitty litter.
- *The medications will be less appealing to children, pets and unrecognizable to people who may intentionally go through your trash.*
- Put them in sealable bag, empty can, or other container to prevent the medication from leaking or breaking out of a garbage bag and dispose of in a trashcan.
- When in doubt about proper disposal, talk to your pharmacist or local health department.

Before throwing out a medicine container, SCRATCH OUT ALL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION on the prescription label to make it unreadable. This will help protect your identity and privacy of your personal health information.
