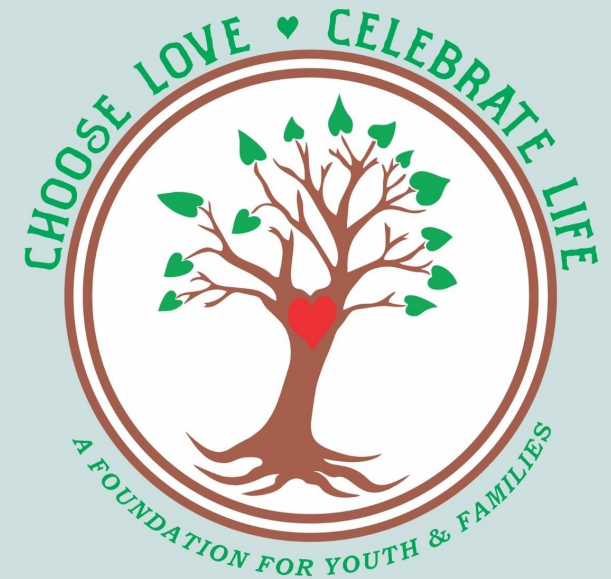

TreeHouse Care Connection- A "Warm Line" Referral Service

Introducing a groundbreaking pilot program focused on proactive support and referrals, available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, beginning in January 2025.

The aim is to better connect families in need to resources available and, in doing so, reduce poverty-based child maltreatment allegations. We will link individuals in need with essential resources by facilitating connections to donation sites. Through CLCL, callers seeking assistance for themselves or those in the community will be referred to the appropriate resources within Ocean and Monmouth Counties.

Community Groups

Coming January, The TreeHouse Outreach will offer FREE Family Fun Nights to provide connection and foster positive shared experiences. Upcoming groups will include Peer-to-Peer and Kinship Navigation Program.

Any youth in crisis, such as:
Runaways (10-17), homeless (18-19),
homeless young adults (18-24)

And our TreeHouse Care Connection and outreach groups are available to the community at large.

Home Share Solutions Program

18-24 year olds face many barriers to housing including: rental history, credit history, eviction history, and landlord reference. This Pilot Program will connect young people to community members who will become their landlord. This unique partnership can help struggling homeowners, people with a fixed income, and young people.

Both landlord and renter will receive background checks and fingerprints. CLCL will collaborate with community partners to help young people receive independent living skills, build credit, and address mental health issues.

After a year's time and free of these barriers, participants will have the supports and skills required to allow them to live independently. Provides: Personality Assessments, Meet and Greet Events, Mediation, and Legal Lease Agreements
